

Q: What is Playtime Adventure?

Playtime Adventure is a unique program designed to develop children 3-6 years of age. Focusing on improving a child's Fundamental Motor Skills (FMS) in a fun, parent participatory atmosphere utilizing age appropriate activities and storybook adventures.

Q: Is Playtime Adventure a Day Care?

Q: How long is the program? It is a one hour class.

Q: Why is Playtime Adventure important for my children?

- Improve the child's Fundamental Motor Skills (Physical Literacy)

Q: Who runs the program?

Professional Playtime Adventure Instructors conduct the program. Ratio of instructor to child is maximum 1 to 8.

Q: What do we receive as part of the program?

You and your child receive a Playtime Adventure T-shirt each.

The unique Playtime Adventure Activity Storybook with movement guides. Playtime Adventure 'Soccer Treasures' on completion of each adventure. And the Playtime Adventure Finale Party.



Q: What is the storybook for?

As part of the program, each parent / child will receive a Playtime Adventure Storybook. The storybook will follow the curriculum and the various weekly themes. The fully illustrated storybook will include the adventures and motor skills guides. The adventures and skill development can therefore be replicated at home. Additionally, the child can color in the earned 'treasure part' in the Soccer Player coloring page. The sequence of class and home participation continues until, skill by skill, all treasure is collected. And so, by the end of the Playtime Adventure program, the coloring of the Soccer Player is complete.

Q: Who are 'Team Adventure'?

The Story....Can you help 'Team Adventure' find the lost Soccer Treasure that has been scattered throughout Adventure-land? Each one hour class is a full adventure. To complete the adventure the child utilizes and develops specific motor skills. Parents are actively involved in each adventure and home learning.

At the end of each class, once the child has found the lost soccer treasure, the child will receive a Soccer Treasure sticker that can be placed in the 'Gold Space' on the corresponding page of the storybook.

Q: Do you have any after program education to help parents?

In the storybook, each specific skill has a color guide and bullet point description. This information allows the parent to evaluate and improve their child motor skills at home.
